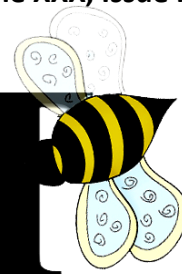

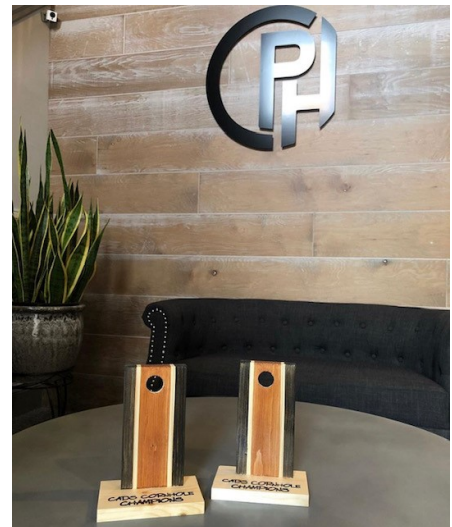

Stepping into the Program Director role for Miller-Motte Technical College was very exciting. There are many changes taking place in our program, we are confident this will make the program excel. Recently several stops have been made at local dental offices, asking for input on the program, requesting feedback for any changes that offices feel are necessary but also, inquiring what the community felt were the strong points in our program in the past. Anything that MMTC has been given has been further reviewed and put into consideration. The MMTC Dental program has so many opportunities for both students and offices and we are so excited to be able to share this with the Chattanooga community.
